

IT'S FIELD TRIP TIME AGAIN!

Dear Parents,

The Kids' Angling Clinic field trip will be held on **Thursday, May 4th**. The Angling Clinic is designed to be a fun day for students. In the morning students will rotate through four stations, learning about a variety of angling topics such as:

- * Fishing tackle & angling methods
- * Knots
- * Fish biology & care of the catch
- * Casting practice, water safety



Lunch will be provided for the students and volunteers by the local fishing clubs. Following lunch, students will be assigned in groups of 2 or 3 to a fishing coach. They will fish in Shevlin Pond and if they are lucky, may catch and keep two trout. The trout will be cleaned and placed in a zip-loc bag and brought back to school in an ice chest. We will transport the fresh catch home to you for dinner. Certified angling instructors and volunteers from the Central Oregon Flyfishers and Sunriver Anglers will be reinforcing topics we are studying in the classroom.

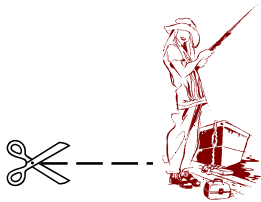
