On a large sheet of paper, carefully draw a map of Oregon and mark the following. Use your Oregon textbook and whatever other references you would like.

1. Make a key and symbols to represent items on the map.
2. Label the following cities:
Portland, Salem, Eugene, Corvallis, Redmond, Medford, Klamath Falls, The Dalles, and Newport.
3. Draw and label the following rivers:
Columbia River, Willamette River, Deschutes River, John Day River, and Snake River.
4. Draw and label these mountains and mountain ranges:
Mt. Hood, Mt. Jefferson, Mt. Washington, Three Sisters, Blue Mountains, Wallowa Mountains, Coast Range.
5. Divide and label the four landform regions of Oregon:
Oregon Coast, Willamette Valley, Cascades, and Eastern Oregon.
6. Draw and label the Pacific Ocean and the states bordering Oregon:
Washington, Idaho, Nevada, and California.
7. Extra credit: Feel free to add more information to your map if you wish.
